President Frye reviewed the proposed Agenda for conducting the Annual Meeting. He advised that there was one (1) change to the Agenda, which was to add Election of Directors following the Treasurer's Report. There being no objections to the Agenda as amended, it was approved and adopted. President Frye then appointed the Parliamentarian, Sergeant-at-Arms, and Vote Tellers.




